New Water Operator in 2020

The District has contracted with a new water operator in 2020. Dave Marsa has been our wastewater operator for over two years and will now oversee both water and wastewater for the district. He brings 25 years of experience as a water operator and holds the highest state certification level for water treatment. Additionally, this change will result in cost savings for the district. 2020 Fire Mitigation Projects

The DW2 Metro District routinely performs fire mitigation in the green-space and open areas that we collectively own. We have contracted with FireSmart to continue mitigation this spring. The focus will be the perimeter land surrounding our neighborhood, the "triangle" located roughly between the 100-200 block of Oak Drive and Spruce Court, and areas adjacent to the emergency exit at the end of Aspen Drive. We are coordinating a meeting in late February for residents to learn more and have any concerns addressed. The owner of FireSmart will be at the meeting. We will keep you posted on the date and time for this meeting.

Bill Pay Bank Checks Reminder

Just a reminder to residents that monthly district payments must be received by the district by the 4th of each month. Many residents choose to pay their bill via a "Bill Pay" option through their banks where the bank drafts a

check and mails it. This puts you at the mercy of the postal service and can result in late receipt by the district, which means you are subject to late fees. In order to avoid this, please build some time into your banking cycle so that we receive these checks by the 4th of each month. Alternatively, you can sign up for autopay through DW2. With autopay, your payment is always drawn on the 5th of each month – one day after the due date, and you can be sure to avoid late fees. This is a paperless option that is more cost effective for your bank as well as the district. To set up autopay, email dw2@mydurango.net and we can send you an easy form to fill out.

Drive and Walk Safely, Especially on Icy Roads!

Winter is here and it is important to remember that roads may become quite slick in the subdivision in the coming months. Please slow down and take your time while traveling through the neighborhood, particularly on wintery days. Be considerate of your neighbors walking on the streets by reducing your speed and exercising more caution especially around curves. In the winter when it's more difficult for cars to maneuver and stop, it's important that people walking on the road stay close to one side of the road to ensure safe passage of two vehicles as well as the pedestrians.
